

3X2 Chess Tournaments

Matching system

The match system of Chess 3X2, is a modality where all the participants play two games against two opponents at the same time with white and black.

All the participants must play double number of games with different opponents, with the programmed number of rounds, and besides, everyone must play an equal number of games with black and white pieces.

The number of participants must be multiple of THREE (3^n), this allows to hold Round Robin system competitions and tournaments with a number of scheduled rounds. (See box of 27 players).

Tournaments with a number of programmed rounds.

A) Basic principles

- 1.- The number of rounds to be disputed will be announced in advance.
- 2.- The number of participants must be a multiple of three.
- 3.- The points of the two games of each round, will be grouped in a single score.
- 4.- The final classification is determined by the sum of the points obtained in each of the rounds: Two games won (one round) 3 points, one game won 1 point, one tie 1/2 point and 0 point the lost game.

B) General rules of pairings

- 1.- The participants will be sorted according to FIDE valuation, from highest to lowest. Unrated players will be sorted according to the alphabetical order of the surnames, starting with the first one. The name will be used with equality of surnames.
- 2.- The players will be grouped in groups of three, consecutively starting with the first of the list.
- 3.- In the case that any player / s does not form a pairing group, he / she will be granted rest and he / she will score 2 points.
- 4.- Before starting the tournament, the round will be raffled for which it must begin, excluding from this the first round, which will be played at the end of the draw.
- 5.- When you intend to play a round trip, the players of lower rank will exchange positions.

C) Composition of the tables:

- 1.- The tables will be arranged numerically starting with Table No.1 and three tables will be placed on each table.
- 2.- In each of the tables assigned to each pairing group, the three players will be placed in such away that to the left of the player with the highest rating will be placed the player with the rating closest to him and to the right the other player.

D) Tiebreakers: In accordance with the FIDE Rules.

E) Any anomaly or discrepancy not contemplated in these Rules, will be resolved by the referee and its decision must be accepted by the players.
